## *PARENT-SCHOOL COMPACT*

### ***THE SCHOOL WILL:***

- Hire and retain highly qualified teachers and instructional assistants.
- Provide additional learning opportunities for struggling students and enhance learning for accelerated students.
- Help direct you to resources that are available for your family needs.
- Ensure the safety of the students.
- Contact parents when teachers notice a change in their child's grades, class work, or behavior.

### ***STUDENTS WILL:***

#### BE RESPONSIBLE

- Be responsible for my own learning: I will get plenty of sleep and eat breakfast. I will have a good attitude at school.
- Show traits of a good learner: I will reflect, question, problem solve, collaborate, communicate thinking, and persevere in my learning.
- Pay attention in class: I will be on-task at all times. I will have my eyes on my teacher when learning. I will keep my hands and feet to myself and not disrupt the class.
- Use technology appropriately: I will not play around on the computers. I will follow the Provo City School District Acceptable Computer System Use Policy.
- Complete my homework and turn it in to my teacher: I will be responsible by doing my homework in homework club or at home. I will make sure I turn in my homework before anything else.

#### BE RESPECTFUL

- Not bully other students: I will not physically or emotionally hurt other students.
- Not talk back: When my teacher asks me to do something, I will do it. I will not talk back because it is disrespectful and I could get in trouble.
- Not swear: If I get mad, I will not swear.
- Follow the dress code: I will not wear inappropriate clothes

#### BE SAFE

- Help others, not hurt them: I will make others feel safe at school.
- Follow school rules: I will not run in the halls. I will not write on the walls. I will use the playground equipment properly.
- Not play in the bathroom: I will not throw toilet paper. I will not play with the soap. I will not spill water on the floor. I will flush the toilet after using it.
