Go Over Proposed Trustland Plan and Vote

- Very similar to last year's plan. This is go into effect for the 2016-17 year. Some specifics with interventions.
 - Tier 3 intervention has been targeted more and added math tier 3 time.
- Goals
 - Language Arts SAGE Testing (3-6) increase from 47% to 52%. DIBELS Testing (K-2) - increase from 59% to 70%
 - Math SAGE Testing (3-6) increase from 48% to 54%.
- Financial Proposal Estimated carry-over \$18,000 from 2015-2016. This will allow us to keep the same amount of teachers that we have this year. Estimated distribution for 2016-2017 \$37,050.
 - This money will pay for three aides and one teacher. If we are allotted more we will use the extra money for more aides.
- Mr. McCarty proposes that we vote on this plan. 4 yes 0 no.
