SCHOOL BACKGROUND

Constructed in 1997-1998, Amelia Earhart Elementary serves the southwest corner of Provo. Built to house 550 students, the school opened on Tuesday, August 25, 1998. The school is on a traditional schedule and opened with an enrollment of over 550 students. The school name was chosen from patron and student input. The school motto is "Flying High with Pride." The school mascot is the Aviator. In 2001, six additional classrooms were built on to help facilitate growth in the area.

Curriculum

- Researched based programs in literacy and math
- 3-tier model with daily differentiated interventions in literacy and math
- PE, music, choir, and art are offered for all students
- Extensive before and after school programs
- Enrichment and Gifted/Talented opportunities

Computers and Technology

- All regular classrooms are 1:1 (One Chromebook for every student)
- 1 iPad lab for Kindergarten
- Classrooms are equipped with enhanced sound systems with a teacher microphone and a handheld student microphone
- All classrooms have an interactive touch screen panel

SUCSESSES

- Implementation of Professional Learning Communities—teachers meet weekly for 90 minutes to discuss student needs, guaranteed essentials, common assessments, enrichment, targets and reteaching
- All regular education teachers have completed or are enrolled in an ESL endorsement program.
- We have 45 students participate in the school choir, 27 6th graders in the school orchestra, and 16 in band, and 8 in the ukulele class.
- After School programs which support students social & emotional development and includes a popular Musical Theatre program.
- Implementation of Flight School, a pre-school option for 4 year olds and their caregivers which prepares students to become lifelong learners.
